About Your Building

Building Name and address: Moorcot Court, Bideford Drive, Wythenshawe, M23 0QW

Number of floors and apartments: 9 Floors, 70 self-contained flats

Main use: Residential

Year built and major refurbishments: year built 1969, major refurbishments - Fire alarms (2018), Lift refurbishment + standby generator (2018), Sprinklers (2020),
- External wall & roof renewal (2022–23), Flat entrance fire doors (2024).

Key Safety Risks

Fire safety risks: Combustible materials managed, single stairway, enclosed balconies

Structural safety risks: Concrete frame integrity, unknown foundation type, ongoing damp checks

Other risks: Gas removed from flats, negligible flood risk

Safety Measures in Place

Fire safety systems: BS5839-1 fire alarm system, BS5839-6 LD1 alarms in flats, sprinklers installed

Structural integrity checks: Annual structural surveys, compartmentation surveys, quarterly communal door checks.

Emergency lighting and signage: Installed throughout escape routes

Resident safety guidance: Stay Put policy, evacuation info on noticeboards

How We Manage Safety

Regular Fire Risk Assessments: Annual Type 3 FRA by Total Fire Group, tracked via Aurora portal

Maintenance schedule: Monthly checks for firefighting equipment, annual door inspections

Resident engagement: Building Safety booklet, High Rise Forum feedback, QR code for PEEPs

Building Safety Officer block visits

Emergency Procedures

Evacuation plan: Stay Put strategy unless instructed otherwise by Fire Service

Assembly point location: Front of Moorcot Court
