



Great Places Panel:

The Great Places Panel's role in the Involvement Structure is to give residents a voice into the Great Places element of the Corporate Plan 2020 - 22.

The Purpose of the Great Places Panel is to:

- Help make Wythenshawe a great place to live. The Panel will contribute to our work to make the area safe, attractive and fit for the future.
- The Great Places Panel will meet every quarter at first but this might increase with actions and work to be completed between meetings by residents and staff and reviewed at each meeting
- The Chair of the Great Places Panel will report on progress to Tenant Committee every 6 months
 - Panels will have a minimum of 6 members and no upper limit
- Provide assurance that the improvements from the Hackitt Review contained in Building Safety Bill are being implemented and that resident voice is central.
- Oversee our investment programme to make sure our approach provides residents with Value for Money on their home improvements.
- Support the Sustainability Working Group to deliver the communication of the Low Carbon Agenda to residents
 - Work alongside Officers to develop a Green and Blue Strategy
 - Be the Champions for community environmental services

- Support TARAs to engage in managing green spaces
- Receive updates and provide scrutiny to our Grounds Maintenance and Concessionary Services
- Be the initial resident voice and provide assurance to WCHG that any changes to our Systems that affect customers will improve residents' services and are Value for Money
