



Living Well Panel:

The Living Well Panel's role in the Involvement Structure is to give residents a voice into the Living Well element of the Corporate Plan 2020 - 22.

The Purpose of the Living Well Panel is to:

- Provide resident voice and scrutiny into our value-added services that are designed to help and support people.
- The Living Well Panel will meet every quarter but hopefully more in the future, with actions and work to be completed between meetings by residents and staff and reviewed at each meeting
 - Panels will have a minimum of 6 members and no upper limit
- The Chair of the Living Well Panel will report on progress to Tenant Committee every 6 months
- Work with young people in Wythenshawe to make sure that their voice is heard and their Youth Service is fit for purpose
- Provide scrutiny to WCHG's employment service offer to provide assurance to residents that it is providing Value for Money
- Work with staff on our approach to Community Safety so that residents feel happy and safe in their homes
- Support WCHG's approach to Domestic Abuse so that the service is safeguarding the most vulnerable.
- Alongside TARAs, have oversight of the Neighbourhood Plans to make sure they are delivered as agreed

- Provide scrutiny to the Tenancy Management Team to provide assurance that our properties are being allocated fairly
